The San Juan Island Yacht Club proudly announces the 38th Annual Shaw Island Classic Yacht Race to be held Saturday, August 9, 2008, and invites all eligible boats and crews to participate. The race is scheduled to start at noon on August 9, 2008 from Friday Harbor, around Shaw Island in either direction, and back to Friday Harbor for Lasagna Dinner and awards presentation at the clubhouse.

Eligibility: The race is open to multihulls, unballasted centerboards, registered PHRF boats and cruising sailboats of all sizes and rigs. Classes will be provided for multihulls, centerboards, PHRF and cruising classes. Flying sails (as defined by PHRF-NW) are permitted in all classes except the cruising class. Entrants for the PHRF class should have a valid PHRF-NW certificate, all entries should submit a rating certificate if they have one. Entries without a certificate will be assigned a rating by the committee.

Rules: The race will be sailed under the Racing Rules for Sailing (RRS 2005-2008) as published by US Sailing. All entries must meet the appropriate US or Canadian Coast Guard safety requirements. Racing rule 75 is waived (yacht club membership is not required), and the race is designated Category A (no advertising) under ISAF Regulation 20. Entrants are reminded that float-planes and ferries are restricted in their ability to maneuver and should be given right-of-way under the Collision Reg's.

Entries: Entry forms are attached to this notice, or may be obtained at the clubhouse, or downloaded from the club's website at www.sjiyc.com, or by mail to the Club at P.O. Box 67, Friday Harbor 98250. Completed forms, together with the appropriate entry fee (and a valid rating certificate if applicable) may be mailed to the address on the entry form on or before Monday Aug 4, or submitted in person (with a late fee) at the club between 3pm and 9pm on Friday August 8. The final deadline for entries is 9pm on August 8.

Skipper's packets, including Sailing Instructions, must be picked up in person at the clubhouse prior to the race, from 3pm to 9pm on Friday August 8, or from 9 to 10am on Saturday August 9.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded for the first three finishers in each class based on corrected time, adjusted for time-on-time based on PHRF or committee-assigned ratings. The awards presentation will be during the Lasagna Dinner at the clubhouse following the race, at approximately 6:30pm hours.
